

#### ARNPRIOR CURLING CLUB

This information package covers key information required to initiate or renew your 2016-2017 curling membership. Please visit the ACC website throughout the season for up to date club information at **www.arnprior.ovca.com**.

**REGISTRATION** will be using a fillable form this year. Print form and drop into club on Thursday September 22 from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM to register and connect with friends at wine and cheese event.

Print and mail registration to Arnprior Curling Club, P.O. Box 304, Arnprior, Ontario K7S 3H6. Or you can save form as attachment and send by email to **arnprior.curling@gmail.com**.

**NOTE:** All registration forms must be received by Friday September 30, 2016 to allow time for arranging teams and draw schedules for all leagues.

**LEAGUE (S) OF CHOICE** are selected on the registration form as well as preferred position and whether you want to participate in a spares list. The leagues are outlined on page two and three of this package as well as the website.

**PAYMENT** of membership fees offers some options. On registration night September 22, you can pay by cash, cheque, debit or deferred cheque(s). We do not offer credit card payment as an option. If you mail in your registration, you can include cheque(s) payment. If you email your registration, payment can only be done by mail or in person. During the first week of curling October 11- 15, 2016, payment is also accepted. Members with outstanding membership fees after first week of curling cannot continue to curl.

**SIGNED FORMS** should be submitted with your registration. These include the Canadian Curling Association (CCA) waiver and the Privacy form. The CCA waiver must be signed before you commence curling. Final option is submission of all signed forms during the first week of curling October 11-15, 2016.

VOLUNTEERING is not required for new curlers and optional for returning curlers. Those who chose to volunteer will receive a discounted membership fee for assisting in the operation of club events. On September 22, a volunteer kiosk will be set-up for signing up for an event. Volunteer form can also be mailed in or submitted during first week of curling.

**NEW CURLERS** are directed to the Learn to Curl program which runs weekly for eight weeks from Friday October 21, 2016 until Friday December 16, 2016. You will receive instruction, the loan of a broom and slider and a free griper. On completion of this program you can continue in one of the other leagues by paying the balance of the once a week registration fee. If you're undecided about curling, register for the free Try Curling event held Saturday October 15 and Sunday October 16, 2016.

**PROMOTIONS** include membership discounts for members aged 21-31 and also for those who chose volunteering option. The member-get-a-member bonus has been continued. Details on ACC website.

	EVENING LEAGUES		
Monday Night Competitive	This fixed league is open to teams (of any combination) who wish to curl at a higher competitive level. If your team desires good curling, this league is for you. First 16 teams are guaranteed a spot.		
Tuesday Night Mixed Social	This league is for beginners, novice and the not-so-serious curler (low competition & high fun). With only 6 ends of curling being played, the prime objective is to have fun, meet people and socialize. Teams are redrawn every 4 to 5 weeks. First 64 individuals registered are guaranteed a spot.		
Wednesday Night Mixed	This league is for curlers who want to experience a mix of good curling and social camaraderie. Good sportsmanship and spirited play are what this evening is all about. Teams are redrawn every 4 to 5 weeks. First 64 individuals registered are guaranteed a spot.		
Thursday Night Open Mixed	This open league is for the more competitive curler who wants to develop their curling skills further in a more competitive and demanding environment. Sign-up either as a team or individually. Good sportsmanship and spirited play are what this evening is all about. First 16 teams are guaranteed a spot.		
Friday Night "Learn to Curl" Mentor Program	Mentor Program is for new curlers and beginners wanting to sharpen their skills. The program will run for eight weeks with the first session starting on Friday, October 21, 2016. The program will offer both on-ice and off-ice instruction and includes the loan of a broom and a slider for the on-ice sessions. The cost fort the Friday Night Mentor Program is \$160.00.		
Friday Night Mixed	This league is for curlers with some level of experience. The late draw time to accommodate the 8 week Learn to Curl program, then draw moves to an earlier start time. Teams are fixed and competition level is medium.		
	DAY LEAGUES		
Sunday Drop-in	The Club will be open each Sunday PM for anyone wanting to get extra playing / practice time. All efforts possible will be made to make someone available to provide instruction and games can be played if numbers permit. Once a Week Curlers will not be charged extra for this session and persons wanting to experience curling for the first time will be encouraged to attend but only if instruction is available. New curlers will not be charged fees for up to 3 sessions; after 3 sessions they will be charged \$25.00 per session / per person.		
Monday Open Fixed	Level of competition is medium. Teams are fixed for the season. Register as a team or a single looking for a team. Open to teams of any combination. Eight end games. Maximum of 16 teams.		
Tuesday and Friday Drop-in	Level of competition is low to medium. For those looking to get some extra curling. Regular draws are made-up from name tags handed –in when they arrive at the rink prior to game time
