

### **ARNPRIOR CURLING CLUB**

This information package contains information to initiate or renew your curling membership. Throughout the season for updated information please <a href="www.armprior.ovca.com">www.armprior.ovca.com</a> and The Arnprior Curling Club Page on Facebook.

**NEW THIS SEASON:** Mixed doubles curling league is being considered pending the results of the survey sent to all members in mid-August. **Snowbird** membership is continued from last season (equivalent of half season with flexible start and stop times). **Spare Only** membership has been dropped due to lack of interest. **Drop-in fee** for non-members continued on day curling or Friday night league, requiring signed waiver once and payment of \$15.00 at the bar for each game played.

**REGISTRATION NIGHT** will be Thursday **September 19, 2019** at the club from 6-9 PM. We will be featuring the popular reduced beverages pricing of \$2.00. Come reconnect with friends and enter to win a \$25.00 coupon applicable to registration, the bar or the pro shop. We hope to have a beer tasting event scheduled that night as well to gauge member feedback.

**REGISTRATION FORM** completion online is preferable. **Save your form first and then click the submit button** and your form will be delivered to the ACC email address. If you have missed some portion of the form it will be detected. You will need to fix before sending is enabled. If you have difficulty, please contact registrar. There will be people to assist you at club on registration night as well. Deadline is **September 30, 2019** to allow time for team composition and draw scheduling.

**PAYMENT:** Online payment is not available but there are a variety of payments options such as cash, cheque, Visa, Mastercard or derferred cheques. Payment must be received by first week of curling **October 15-18, 2019.** 

**SIGNED CCA WAIVER FORMS** must be completed <u>before you start curling</u>. Please print and sign the form at home. Waiver forms will also be available to sign on registration night.

**LEAGUE(S) OF CHOICE** should include all leagues you want to join, your preferred position, and when you are available for sparing. If you are on a fixed team, we require the name of your skip. **League descriptions** are on page 3. **Draw schedule** is on page 2.

**VOLUNTEERING** is not required for new or youth members and is optional for returning members. The club depends on our volunteer base to run smoothly, so you will receive a discounted fee in appreciation. A Volunteer Board by the bar is available to sign up for events. If you receive a discounted fee but do not fulfill the hours, you will need to repay a pro-rated fee. **SOCIAL EVENTS** listings are on page 4.

**NOVICE CURLERS** are directed to the Learn to Curl program. It is a 5 week program that commences **October 27, 2019**. You will receive instruction, a free gripper and the loan of a broom and a slider. On completion of the program you will be directed to day curling, Friday night league, and Tuesday night if space permits.

**TRY CURLING** will be held **October 20 / 21, 2019**. It's an open house with some instruction. Try curling before committing to Learn to Curl. Get your ice legs back after an absence from curling.

Monday	This league is ideal for curlers desiring a high level of competition. It is a fixed team composition. You can join as a team or as an individual to be		
	assigned to a team. The first 16 teams are guaranteed a spot.		
Tuesday	This league appeals to novice and the not so serious curlers. Games are 6		
	ends only. The emphasis is on having fun and meeting people. Teams		
	rotate every 4-5 weeks. The first 64 curlers are guaranteed a spot.		
Wednesday	This is a semi competitive league. Games are 8 ends. Teams rotate every		
	4-5 weeks. The first 64 curlers are guaranteed a spot.		
Thursday	This is a competitive league for curlers wishing skill development and a		
·	more demanding environment. You can join as a team or as an individual		
	to be assigned a team. The first 64 curlers are guaranteed a spot.		
Friday	This league is for novice and low competitive curlers. Teams are rotating		
-	or fixed by consensus decision. Drop-in curlers will be accommodated.		
	DAY LEAGUES		
Sunday	Learn to Curl is a 5 week program that runs from October until end of		
·	November. Basic instruction of curling skills is provided.		
Sunday	Open time is available in the afternoon for instruction or practice. Once a		
,	week curlers are not charged extra fees for this slot.		
	Inexperienced non-member curlers can only go on ice if an instructor is		
	available. They can participate a maximum of 3 times, after which they pay		
	\$15.00 per session/ per person. Signed waivers required.		
Monday	This league is semi-competitive. It is fixed team composition. You can join		
•	as a team or as an individual to be assigned to a team. Games are 8 ends.		
	The first 16 teams will be guaranteed a spot.		
Tuesday / Friday	This league is low to semi-competitive play. Games played Tuesday		
	afternoon and Friday morning. Drop-in format. Grab your curling position		
	tag from the day curling board, hand in to convener, and teams will be		
	assembled prior to game.		
	OPTIONAL DAY LEAGUES		
Friendlies	Mixed teams. Play 8 ends in the morning with lunch for \$10.00. Area clubs		
	take turns hosting curling. Frequency is up to 8 games per season. Sign up		
	on day curling board.		
Low Cup	Men's league. Two 8 end games played on Wednesday with lunch for		
	\$12.00. Area clubs take turns hosting curling. Frequency is 10-12 games		
	per season. Sign up on day curling board.		
Autumn Leaves	Ladies League. Area clubs take turns hosting curling. Frequency is up to 4-		
	6 games per season. Sign up on day curling board.		
2-2-2	Team composition is 2 ladies + 2 men with combined age 222. Two 6 end		
	games are played with lunch in between. Area clubs take turns hosting		
	curling. Frequency is 4-6 games per season. Sign up on day curling board.
